IST is a fully authorized IB World School, offering the Primary Years, Middle Years and Diploma programmes, and is accredited by the New England Association of Schools and Colleges (NEASC) and the Council of International Schools (CIS).









The International School of Turin (IST) is a non-profit and private coeducational, Englishmedium school offering programmes from the Early Years to Grade 12. The school was established in 1963 by a group of parents and members of the foreign community residing in Turin. Their aim was to provide an international education for their children. The IST Community currently has 480 students enrolled, representing 43 different nationalities, with a teaching faculty comprised of 65 members.

Curriculum

Students in the Primary School (EY - Grade 5) follow the IB Primary Years Programme. The IB Middle Years Programme spans Grades 6-10. Italian nationals participate in the state Terza Media examination at the end of Grade 8. The Secondary School culminates with the IB Diploma Programme in grades 11 and 12.

The IB Middle Years Programme (IB MYP)

The Grade 6-10 curriculum at IST falls within the framework provided by the International Baccalaureate Middle Years Programme. This complements our commitment to the IB Diploma in Grades 11-12.

The IB published grade criteria along with the Personal Project are used to measure the final level of achievement in the subject areas listed below:

The IB Diploma Programme (IB DP)

IST's fully accredited Diploma Programme ensures that our graduating students can gain access to the world's best universities.

Students select six subjects. One subject must be selected from each of the following groups:

Group 1 Language & Literature

(HL & SL): English Language & Literature, Italian Literature

Group 2 Language Acquisition (HL & SL): English B (HL only), French B, Italian B, Italian ab initio, Spanish B, German B **Group 3 Individuals & Societies** (HL & SL): Economics, History (Peace-making/Europe), Environmental Systems & Societies. Online Courses (Business and Management and Psychology) are also available.

Group 4 Experimental Sciences (HL & SL): Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Environmental Systems & Societies, Computer Science

Group 5 Mathematics (HL & SL): Analysis and Approaches HL, Analysis and Approaches SL, Mathematics: Applications and Interpretation SL

Group 6 Arts (HL & SL): Visual Arts Options from Groups 1-5. Self-Taught Languages can be arranged for students whose first language is not English or Italian.

The IST Diploma

This Diploma is awarded to all students who have successfully completed the final four years of Secondary School. Credit is given for achievements from IST and any other schools attended. The IST Diploma is valid as a High School Diploma in the USA and therefore at American universities around the world. Credit is awarded by semester. One full credit is earned by completing two semesters of a course that meets 160 minutes per week. The school year consists of 176 teacher-student contact days from September through June.

HOW TO INTERPRET IB GRADES AND TRANSCRIPTS

The minimum graduation requirements consist of 27 high school A credits accumulated over eight semesters of study during Grades or 9-12. The minimum credit requirement for an IST High School a Diploma are: English (4); Foreign Language (4); Mathematics (4); E: Science (3); Humaties (3); Art/Music (1); Physical Education (1); le Theory of Knowledge (1); CAS (1); Electives (5). A minimum grade of 3 (on a 7 point scale) is required to receive credit for a course. Grade Point Averages (GPAs) are not calculated at IST.

A student's examination performance in individual subjects is scored on a scale of 1-7 points with a further 3 points available based on a matrix of performance in the Theory of Knowledge (TOK) and the Extended Essay components. Students who display satisfactory levels of performance across all subject areas and achieve a minimum of 24 points (out of a possible 45) are awarded the IB Diploma. All others receive a Statement of Results for the subjects examined.

Affiliations

IST is also a member of the European Council of International Schools (ECIS) and the Association of IB World Schools in Italy (AIBWSI). IST has also been recognized by the international Foundation for Environmental Education as an official Eco-School.
